

PRIVACY NOTICE

(EU Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons
with regard to the processing of personal data)

The provision of your personal data to “Transparency International Greece (TI-G) as regards the dispatch of newsletters/informative bulletins

TI-G acknowledges and respects the importance of your privacy. This Notice provides you with information on how and why TI-G processes your personal data and outlines your respective rights, in compliance with applicable data protection legislation.

TI-G commits:

1. To process the limited amount and type of personal data necessary for each defined process activity and required service;
2. Not to process your personal data for purposes other than those disclosed to you herein;
3. To safeguard the integrity and confidentiality of your data whilst at our disposal.

To this effect, we wish to inform you on the following:

- 1. Data Controller:** “Transparency International Greece (TI-G)”, a non-profit association seated at Kanigos 19, 106 82, Athens, Greece, email: tihellas@otenet.gr, is the Data Controller for this process, and holds all rights and obligations reserved for such capacity under the Law.
- 2. Types of personal data collected:** Newsletter recipient data (e.g. Your name, email and physical address, contact telephone numbers, fax number, employment and position), indicated through your business details, as available in the course of TI-G’s interactions, or provided by you as our Member, or in the course of events, networking fora, activist groups, or other encounter within the scope of activities of Transparency International.
- 3. Purpose of personal data processing:** a) Record of TI-G Members, b) Communicating TI-G’s views, actions and updates on programmes supervised or conducted by Transparency International and TI-G, or its contracted associates, including the dispatch of invitations to events. Currently we issue the following newsletters:
 1. General Info TI-G,
 2. Newsletter on the project “Integrity pact”,
 3. Newsletter on the project “Integrity watch”,
 4. Newsletter on the project “whistleblowing”,
 5. Newsletter on the project of “Open Government Partnership”
 6. Other informational bulletins, on a regular or ad hoc basis, on major developments and TI-G actions on current affairs (e.g. COVIDD 19, CPI, Eurobarometer)
- 4. Legal basis of personal data processing:** Maintaining our Member register, as well as the pursue of the legitimate interest of TI-G to effectively communicate and network with its members, Stakeholders; Additionally your explicit consent to receive any or all of the above, on a signed consent form basis.
- 5. Third Party Processing**

Your email address(es) are processed on our behalf by the platform “mailchimp” based in the U.S.A, committed to comply with the European Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), used for hosting and dispatch of our newsletter mailing lists. In this process, said company acts as Data Processor. More information on their privacy policy may be found by following this link: [Mailchimp’s Privacy Policy](#)
- 6. Transfer of data outside EU/Profiling:** As already mentioned, your personal data are transferred to the US to the processing headquarters of mailchimp, bound to apply appropriate privacy and security safeguards on the data so processed. Your personal data are not used for profiling purposes.

7. Personal Data Retention Period: Your data is retained securely in our electronic database until we receive your unsubscription request.

Note: *TI-G may retain your personal data for the duration of any period necessary to establish, exercise or defend any legal rights or at such longer retention period as may be required by applicable law.*

8. Your rights to access and manage your personal data:

1. To access the data kept by TI-G
2. To request the rectification of inaccurate data
3. To request the erasure of your data
4. To restrict or object to the processing of your personal data under specific conditions
5. To request the transfer of the data kept by TI-G to any other Data Controller.

Any such request must be made following communication with our email noted above

Note: *The exercise of any of your above rights is subject to applicable regulatory, or operational restrictions.*
